### To all exhibitors/contributors

**Any abusive language or behaviour towards show officials, animals or fellow competitors will result in expulsion from the showground** and by entering this Show you agree to abide by all of the following:

1. All persons entering the showground must have Personal and Public Liability Insurance. The Committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any animal, person or property whilst on the showground. Under NO circumstances must anyone other than the Judge, Stewards, Competitors and Grooms enter the show rings.
2. In the interests of safety, excessive assistance or interference from outside the ring, will not be tolerated.
3. The Judges' decision is final. **Any objections must be made in writing, within one hour of the class/incident and handed to the Secretary with a deposit of £50 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.**
4. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant.
5. The Committee reserve the right to return or refuse any entry made by the on-line entry system.
6. Under no circumstances will/can entries be substituted and any refunds will be totally at the discretion of the Committee and will be subject to the £10 admin charge.
7. In the event of postponement all entries will be carried over to the new date unconditionally.
8. In the event of cancellation, refunds must be requested in writing and should be sent with a SAE enclosed to the Show Secretary within 28 days of the show date and will be subject to a £10 admin charge.
9. Mountain and Moorland ponies to be shown in accordance with the Breed Society rules.
- 10. Stallions may not be lead or ridden by children under the age of 12 years.**
11. The committee reserve the right to carry out random dope testing.
12. All riding hats should adhere to the current British standard.
13. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that they are eligible for the class(es) they enter.

- Class 15 INHAND Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Arab and PB Arab
- Class 16 INHAND Small M&M
- Class 17 INHAND Large M&M
- Class 18 INHAND Veteran - open to all horses and ponies over 16yrs of age.
- Class 19 YOUNG HANDLER not to have attained 10th birthday (minimum age of handler 5 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height, but must be of a suitable type for the handler. No stallions. (1st & 2nd place qualify for Junior Championship to be held after class 24 in Ridden Ring)
- Class 20 YOUNG HANDLER not to have attained 18th birthday (minimum age of handler 11 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height, but must be of a suitable type for the handler. No stallions. (1st & 2nd place qualify for Junior Championship to be held after class 24 in Ridden Ring)
- Class 21 INHAND NCPA Registered Horses and Ponies **1st prizewinner qualifies for President's Cup 2023**
- Class 22 INHAND Christmas Fancy Dress - anything from Christmas jumpers to Christmas puddings. Prize Hamper for the winner
